Directions to the Sisters of Charity Motherhouse

FROM THE NORTH/SOUTH:

From I-75 Freeman Ave. Exit #1F. Follow signs to US 50 West (River Rd). Take River Rd Exit. Take River Rd to Fairbanks and turn right. Bear to left as Fairbanks turns into Delhi Rd. Proceed 3 miles to the campus; continue past college on left to end of Delhi. Cross over Bender Rd, enter the Sister of Charity gates on the right and go down the avenue.

FROM THE EAST:

Follow Columbia Pkwy West to downtown Cinti. Follow signs to US 50 West (River Rd). Follow remainder of above directions.

FROM THE WEST:

Take I-74 east to Exit #5, I-275 South. Follow I-275 South to Exit #21 (Kilby Rd). Turn right and follow to US 50. Turn left (east on US 50/River Rd) and follow to Bender Rd. Turn left onto Bender Rd and follow to Delhi Rd. At the top of Bender Rd, turn right. Enter the Sister of Charity gates on the right and go down the avenue.
